However, because the demand is growing, next year we plan on buying more fridges.

- Thus far I am learning cost saving when purchasing these fridges. Before buying it's important to go through the supplier selection phase, taking into consideration the cost of the fridge and delivery cost.

- Customer Service and Cost Relations. I recently discovered that it seems as though the more we improve customer service transportation costs also go up, so I found a driver to partner to reduce transport cost.
- Our Pricing Strategies were also determined using inferential statistics and descriptive statistics models after studying the target population.
